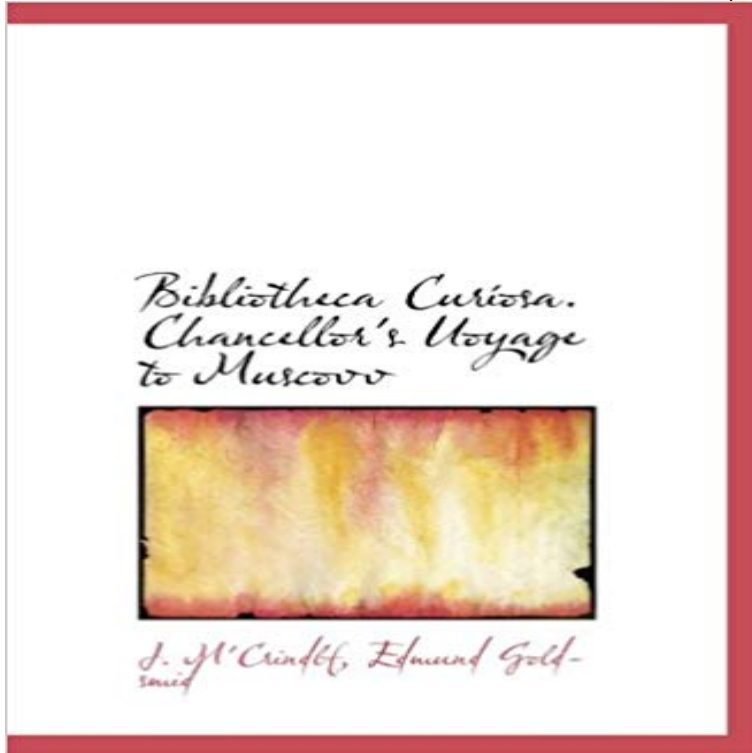


Bibliotheca Curiosa. Chancellors Uoyage to Muscovv
